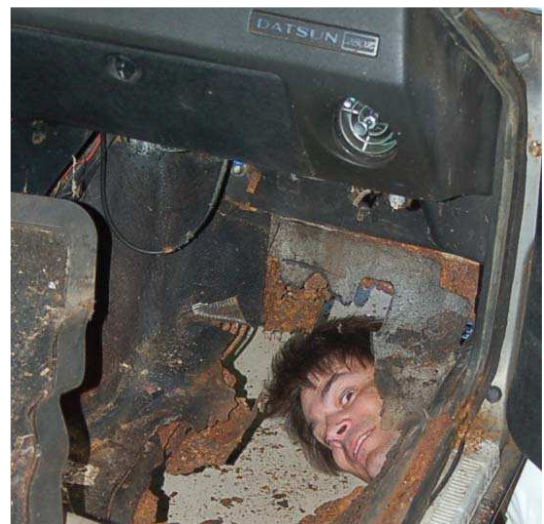

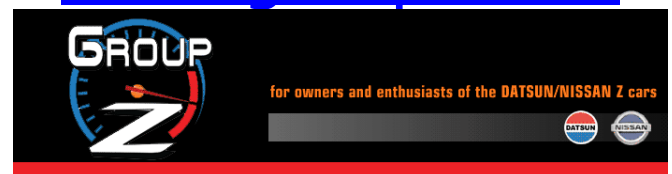
First Nation Wide All Datsun/Nissan Auto Show
